





Seminarians, deacons and religious students are required to include a letter from their bishop or superior stating that their diocese or religious order needs assistance in paying for the student's tuition.*

Note: *Anglican seminarians and diaconal candidates are required to include a letter from their bishop stating that their Anglican diocese is unable to provide the necessary financial support for their candidates and they are in need of assistance in the form of bursaries to help pay for their candidates tuition.*
